

Boulevard Décarie scheduled to close January 24, 2011

Sir,
Madame,

Ville de Montréal would like to inform you of the January 24 closing of Boulevard Décarie to through traffic between Rue Saint-Jacques and Boulevard De Maisonneuve to permit the construction of 3.6-meter collector sewer.

Traffic

One southbound traffic lane will remain open on Boulevard Décarie, between Avenue Crowley and Rue Saint-Jacques, to allow for local traffic and MUHC trucks.

Customers, merchants, and residents who wish to access Boulevard Décarie must do so via avenues Prud'homme and Crowley or, as well, Chemin Upper Lachine and Avenue Crowley (new access).

Expected work

Significant work will also be done during the next five (5) months at the intersection of Rue Saint-Jacques and Boulevard Décarie. This underground infrastructure work will consist of the construction of water mains and sewers and their associated works as well as the reconstruction of the pavement and sidewalks. More specific information regarding the impact of this work will be communicated shortly.




