SPVM POLICY ON STREET CHECKS VIRTUAL PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The Commission de la sécurité publique (the committee) will hold a public consultation on the SPVM's new policy on street checks.

STEP 1 – GET INFORMED

The SPVM will present its policy during a virtual public meeting, which will be held as follows:

The purpose of the virtual public meeting is to answer questions from the public and provide clarification on the policy. The SPVM will present the policy, and then answer written questions from the public submitted in advance as well as questions from committee members.
