## Modernization of the water supply system

### Boulevard des Anciens-Combattants

**Start of work: August 13, 2020**

The city will be performing work to modernize the water supply system on Boulevard des Anciens-Combattants, between Avenue Pacific and the entrance ramps to Highway 40, from August 13 to September 4, 2020.

#### Nature of the work

This work is part of the project to optimize the main drinking water supply system in the greater Montréal area. The construction and repair of the infrastructure required to regulate pressure will facilitate the management and operation of the water supply system and will reduce water main breaks.

#### Traffic

##### Boulevard des Anciens-Combattants

- Two southbound lanes will be closed to traffic between Pacific Avenue and the entrance ramps to Highway 40.
- One southbound contraflow lane will be open to traffic.
- One northbound lane will be open to traffic.

*Drivers are asked to show caution around the work zones, drive at moderate speeds and respect the signage in place.*

#### Work duration and schedule

- August 13 to September 4, 2020
- Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Work may be carried out during evenings and weekends, if necessary.

Please note that work activities may be moved or extended due to unfavourable weather conditions or other constraints.

#### Drinking water supply

Interruptions of the drinking water supply are planned. Affected residences will be notified 48 hours in advance. We ask that you pay special attention to these notices so as to be well prepared and minimize any inconveniences.

#### Impacts of the work

- **Street parking:** Parking restrictions will apply in the work zone and on neighbouring streets.
- **Access to buildings:** Pedestrian access to the buildings around the work site will be maintained at all times. The sidewalks will generally be accessible but may be obstructed during certain phases of the work.
- **Public transit:** Public transit will be maintained. Schedules, routes and bus stop locations may change. Please contact the STM-INFO service (514-786-4636 or [WWW.STM.INFO/EN](http://WWW.STM.INFO/EN)).
- **Noise and dust:** Dust and noise may be generated by trucks circulating in the area.
