## Redevelopment of Pointe-Claire's drinking water production plant

Exploratory digs: Week of June 15, 2020

The city will spend a day carrying out **exploratory digs** at the Pointe-Claire plant **during the week of June 15, 2020**. Excavation work will take place in the yard behind the drinking water production plant.

#### Nature of the work

These exploratory digs will be performed in preparation for the plant's redevelopment work, which will take place from July 2020 to November 2021. This work is part of the project to bring drinking water plants in the greater Montréal area up to current safety standards.

Residents will receive further updates regarding future phases of the work.

#### Schedule of work

• 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Note: This work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or other constraints.

#### **Drinking water supply**

There is no plan to shut off the drinking water supply. This work will have no impact on the quality of drinking water.

#### Anticipated impact of the work

• **Noise and dust:** Noise and dust may be generated by the presence of trucks and the use of a power shovel.

The city thanks you for your cooperation and will use all the means at its disposal to limit the impacts of carrying out this work.

#### COVID-19

The resumption of construction work is part of the Québec government's plan to reopen various economic sectors during the COVID-19 pandemic. The resumption of work is a clear sign of the city's economic recovery and is being deployed in line with the prevention conditions recommended by Québec's public health authorities.

Measures will be in place to prevent the risk of contamination for workers and other people at or near the construction sites. At the same time, please remember that infection control is everyone's responsibility.

The city will assess the situation regularly and ensure that all measures recommended by the Direction régionale de santé publique are implemented.
