- When registering online, a \$10 payment on account per activity will be invoiced and must be paid immediately by credit card (with the exception of the daycare service)\*.
  - \* Daycare fees will be added to your final invoice.
- A Borough carte-loisirs is mandatory for each child and must be valid at the time of registration.
- Invoices can be paid between April 16 and 20 in Room 157 of the Centre des loisirs, from 1 to 8 p.m. Effective April 23, all unpaid invoices will result in the complete and automatic cancellation of the registration. Registrations will not be accepted.
- General registration will take place starting on April 23 in Room 157 of the Centre des loisirs. Registrations will be processed in the order in which they are received, and payment must be made on site.

### **FAMILY RATE**

A \$10 discount applies for a second participant registered from the same family, and a \$20 discount applies for the third family member. Exceptions: For the CIT program only, the family discount is \$30 per participant.

Note: For Ville de Montréal non-residents, registration fees will be 33.33% higher to a maximum additional amount of \$50 per camp.

### **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

All day camp registrations made after June 11, 2012 must be paid in full, either in cash or by credit or debit card.

### Policy regarding transfers and refunds after April 23

- If a request is made to cancel a registration, a \$25 cancellation fee will be charged for each participant, and for each week of camp.
- If the cancellation is due to medical reasons, a medical certificate must be presented indicating the period of illness; in this case, a \$25 cancellation fee will be charged for each week, up to a maximum of \$50.
- No requests for transfers or cancellations will be accepted in the 14 days prior to the week in which day camps begin.
- Refunds of \$25 or less will be credited to the account of the parent who originally paid the fee.
- The Borough has final say regarding all transfers and refunds.
