News

Continuous work from May 6 to 9

- Due to the complexity of the work and to minimize the duration of obstructions at the intersection of Saint-Antoine and Rose-de-Lima streets, we are obliged to perform work during the day and night throughout the weekend.

Undesirable effects

- Dust / noise / vibration caused by operations and passing trucks.

Traffic

From May 6 to 9

- Closure of the south side of the intersection of Rue Rose-de-Lima. Local traffic possible on Rue Rose-de-Lima from Rue Saint-Jacques.
- Complete closure of exit 2 from Highway 136 East.
- One westbound lane will remain open on Rue Saint-Antoine, between Avenue Greene and Rue Bourget.

Work schedule

- Friday, May 6 at 9 p.m. to Monday, May 9 at 5 a.m.
- Back to regular schedule on May 9: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Parking

- Restrictions in place. Please heed the signs.

Access to buildings

- Residences, businesses and other establishments will be accessible at all times.

Garbage, recyclables and compost

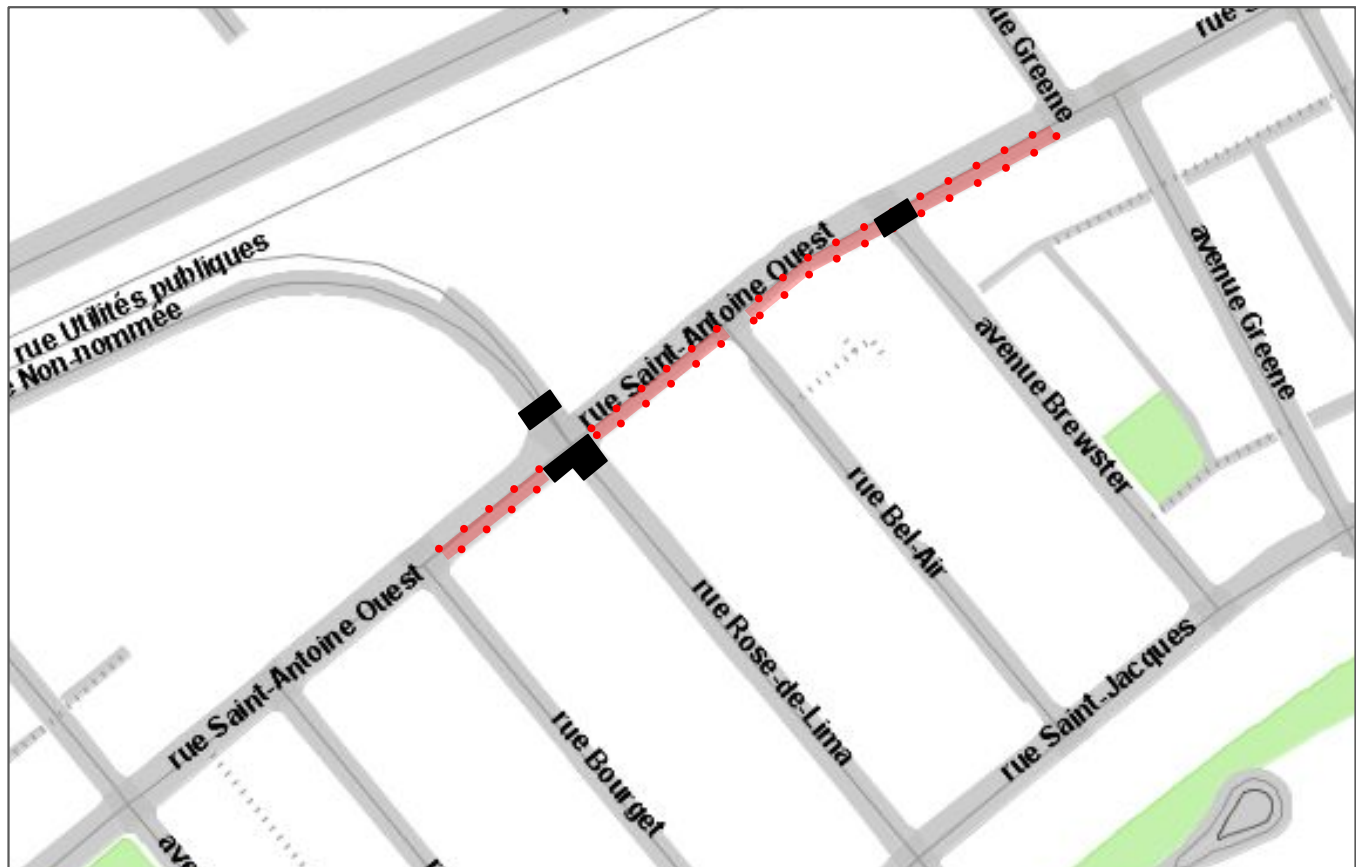
