

2023 PRE-BUDGET CONSULTATION

The <u>Commission sur les finances et l'administration</u> (the committee) invites interested persons to take part in Montréal's 2023 pre-budget consultation.

The consultation will involve three steps. The first step is for you to review the city's proposals, ask questions and receive answers on the subject. The second step provides an opportunity for you to express your views. The third step is the public session to adopt the recommendations, which the committee will submit to the administration at the end of its review.

STEP 1 – OBTAIN INFORMATION

The **documentation** (in French) describing the city's proposals is available on the consultation page at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/consultationprebudgetaire2023</u>. People may also request to receive the documentation by mail, by calling 514-872-3000.

The consultation documents will be presented at a **virtual public information session** which will be held as follows:

DATE AND TIME: WEDNESDAY, MAY 18, 2022, AT 7 P.M.

By videoconference

A link to watch the **webcast of the session** will be available on the day of the meeting at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/consultationprebudgetaire2023</u>.

Following the presentation, time will be set aside for the reading of questions and comments from the public, and then for questions and comments from committee members.
