

# Notice of work

**Avenue Chanteclerc**

**Start : Week of July 18, 2022**

**Ends : Summer 2023**

**Between Boulevard des Sources  
and the Montréal airport**

**Construction of a large-diameter  
drinking water main**

## Impacts on your daily routine

### Traffic

- Closure of Avenue Chanteclerc, from Boulevard des Sources to the Surrey dog park. Local traffic will be permitted.
- Partial obstruction on Boulevard des Sources. One lane shut down between Croissant Dubord and Avenue Chanteclerc.
- Detours are planned to facilitate traffic flow.

### Parking

- There will be restrictions in the work zone. Please heed the signs.

### Temporary interruption of the water supply

- Those affected will receive a door hanger 48 hours in advance.

### Temporary water supply system

July 20 to July 28

- A temporary water supply system will be installed to ensure that buildings located on the north side of Avenue Chanteclerc between Boulevard des Sources and Avenue Deslauriers continue to be supplied with drinking water during the work.

## Good to know

### Access to buildings

- Where sidewalks are obstructed, temporary walkways will provide access to residences and other establishments.

### Garbage, recyclables and compost

- Collection schedules will be maintained. Garbage cans and bins that are not accessible to collectors will be moved by the company performing the work. Each container must be clearly marked with your address so that it can be returned to the right place.

### Access to Surrey dog park

- The park will be accessible, but the northern part will be closed.
