

Did you know?

- Asphalt, a mixture of gravel, sand and tar (bitumen), is very versatile and can be adapted to traffic by varying its thickness. Therefore, it will be thicker on roads regularly used by heavy vehicles and on high-volume traffic lanes than on less busy residential streets.
- Asphalt is also recyclable. Once the existing pavement is removed, it is melted and mixed with the new material and then reused for the new paving.
- In 2019, a work-site squad was formed. Quality control of the infrastructure work during numerous site visits allows us to verify that the materials used meet the required standards as well as to standardize paving techniques.
