**First stage of work**

## Impacts on your daily life

### Traffic

November 7 to December 23, 2022

Rue Saint-Antoine  
westbound

- Two lanes on the south side, between Avenue Atwater and Avenue Greene, will be closed
- Two lanes will be kept open at all times
- Intersections in the work zone will be completely closed
- Local traffic will be permitted on Avenue Marin and Avenue Walker as of Rue Saint-Jacques

Avenue Atwater  
en direction sud

- One lane will be blocked at all times at the corner of Rue Saint-Antoine.
- Two lanes will be blocked during off-peak hours, from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

### Parking

- There will be restrictions in the work zone. Refer to the signs for details.

## Stages of work

### Fall 2022

- Preventive tree pruning
- Reconstruction of duct banks and access shafts by the CSEM between Avenue Atwater and Avenue Greene
- Holiday break from December 23, 2022 to January 16, 2023

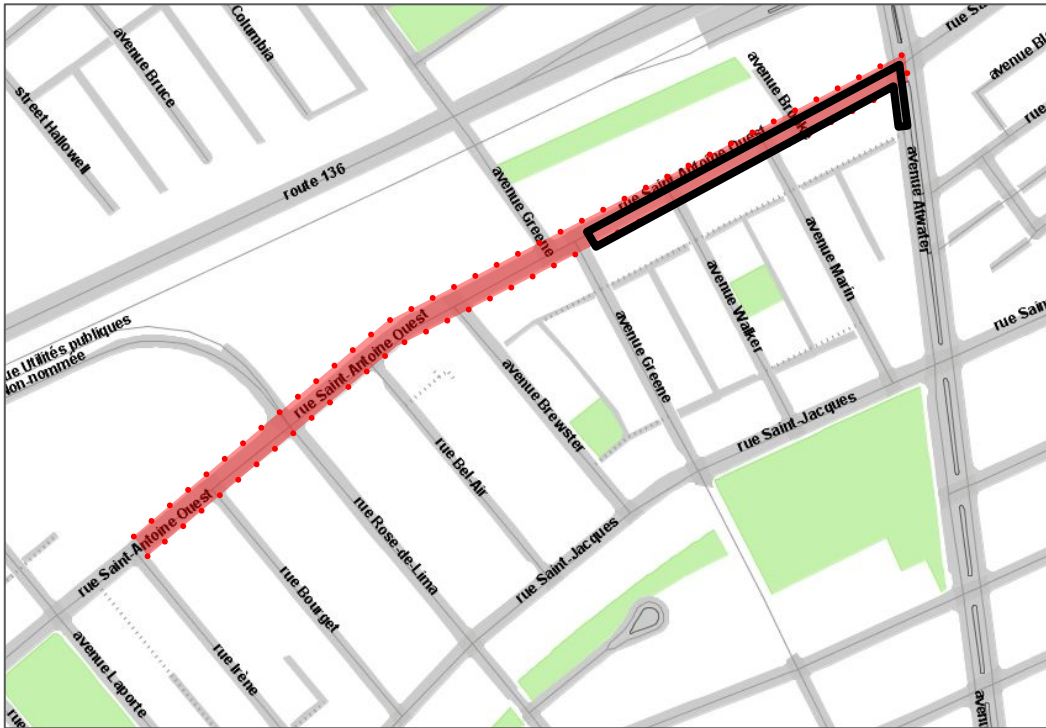
### Winter and spring 2023

- January to March: CSEM work between Avenue Walker and Rue Rose-de-Lima
- March–April: Installation of street lighting bases and ducts between Avenue Atwater and Rue Rose-de-Lima

### Spring to fall 2023

- Roadwork between Avenue Atwater and Rue Irène:
  - Reconstruction of sidewalks and roadway
  - Upgrading of traffic lights and street lighting
  - Construction of planting pits: Approximately 60 trees and 100 perennials will be planted
  - Construction of a protected one-way bike lane

## Access to buildings

- Residences, businesses and other establishments will be accessible. Passageways will provide access to buildings at all times.

## Public transit

- Service will be maintained, but bus stop locations, schedules and routes may change. Information: STM-INFO (514-786-4636) or [www.stm.info/en](http://www.stm.info/en).

## Garbage, recyclables and compost

- Collection schedules will be maintained. Garbage cans and bins that are not accessible to collectors will be moved by the company performing the work. Each container must be clearly marked with your address so that it can be returned to the right place.

- Saturday, 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., if necessary
