BY-LAW CA29 0001-17 MODIFYING BY-LAW CA29 0001 CONCERNING THE DELEGATION OF POWERS TO OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PIERREFONDS-ROXBORO IN ORDER TO DELEGATE TO A PUBLIC EMPLOYEE THE AUTHORITY TO TEMPORARILY ALLOW FLEXIBILITY IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING REGULATIONS

CONSIDERING section 130 of the Charter of the City of Montréal (R.S.Q.c.C-11-4);

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF PIERREFONDS-ROXBORO ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

By-law CA29 0001 is amended as follows:

ARTICLE 1. The following chapter is added after Chapter IV.2

CHAPTER V - Administrative decision regarding traffic and parking

ARTICLE 21

The powers relating to any regulatory provision concerning traffic and parking in the Borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro are delegated to the relevant Level 2 officer.

In the case of a request for an exemption from any regulatory provision relating to traffic and parking, covering all or part of the Borough's territory and granted on an exceptional basis for a specified period, the authorization must specify the territory covered, the duration of the exemption, and any conditions deemed necessary to ensure the safety of users and maintain mobility.

The director of the Borough may, at any time, exercise this authority or reserve the right to exercise it in accordance with sections 2 and 3 of this by-law.

ARTICLE 2 Article 22 is added to Chapter V, "Entry into Force", and shall read as follows:

The present by-law shall take effect in accordance with the Law.

ARTICLE 3 This by-law comes into force according to Law.
