BY-LAW AMENDING THE BY-LAW CONCERNING TRAFFIC AND PARKING (C-4.1) AND OTHER BY-LAW PROVISIONS

At the Montréal city council meeting of March 20, 2000, it was enacted that:

- 1.** Article 2 of the By-law concerning traffic and parking (R.B.C.M., chapter C-4.1) is amended by:
 - (1) adding the following definition after the definition of “total loaded mass”:
““truck”: a road vehicle as defined in section 2 of the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration (order in council 1420-91, October 16, 1991);
 - (2) adding the following definition after the definition of “lane”:
““local delivery”: the local delivery referred to in section 291.1 of the Code;”.
- 2.** Article 31 of that by-law is amended by replacing paragraph 2 by the following:
 - (2) for a truck or special mobile equipment, on a public thoroughfare in a prohibited zone marked off by signs in accordance with the By-law concerning trucks and special mobile equipment (R.B.C.M., chapter C-4.01), except the time required for a local delivery;”.
- 3.** Article 79 of that by-law is amended by replacing “315.1” by “315.2”.
- 4.** Article 1 of the By-law amending the By-law concerning traffic and parking (C-4.1), the By-law concerning the occupancy of public property (O-0.1), and the By-law concerning fees (Fiscal 1999) (98-238) and repealing the By-law concerning trucks and special mobile equipment (96-263) (99-099) is amended:
 - (1) by deleting paragraphs 1 and 3;
 - (2) in paragraph 5:
 - (a) by replacing the word “definitions” by the word “definition”;
 - (b) by deleting the definition of “prohibited zone” that this paragraph introduces in article 2 of the By-law concerning traffic and parking (R.B.C.M. chapter C-4.1).
- 5.** Articles 3 and 4 of that by-law are repealed.
- 6.** Article 13 of that by-law is repealed.
- 7.** Articles 15 to 17 of that by-law are repealed.
- 8.** Articles 19 and 20 are repealed.

9. Article 11 of the By-law concerning traffic and parking (98-049) is repealed.

10. Article 97 of that by-law is amended:

- (1) in paragraph 1, by deleting the number “11,”;
- (2) by deleting paragraph 2.

11. Articles 2 and 3 of the By-law amending the By-law concerning traffic and parking (99-016) are repealed.
