## Form - Step 2

## Collecting signatures on the petition - Borough

### TO OBTAIN A PUBLIC CONSULTATION FROM YOUR BOROUGH

#### In summary

Under the Right of Initiative to public consultations, you have previously filed with your borough a draft petition that has been deemed eligible (Step 1).

You are now at **Step 2**, which involves **collecting signatures on the petition**.

#### Step 2 : Collecting signatures on the petition

**You must obligatorily use the attached form entitled  
Form: Step 2 – Collecting signatures on the petition - Borough**

**Only the form provided by the City may be used. No other form or petition or electronic signatures will be accepted.**

- Enter the name of the borough;
- Enter the object of the requested public consultation;

**You must obligatorily re-enter the same text as on your draft petition (Step 1);**

- Once the form has been filled out, print as many copies as you need;
- Make sure that you collect the required number of signatures from people ages 15 years or over living within the territory of the borough in question;

**All the people who sign the petition solemnly declare that they meet those criteria.**

Please refer to the table hereunder for the number of signatures required for each borough;

- Make sure that you collect the signatures within the 90-day time limit;  
The 90-day period begins on the day that the borough publishes the notice announcing the beginning and end dates for the collection of signatures on your petition.
- Once you have collected the required number of signatures, submit your petition to your borough office;
- **The person responsible will give you a receipt acknowledging your submission;**
- Within 21 days of the filing of your petition, the person responsible at the borough office will inform the contact person in your group of its conformity in terms of the number of signatures required and deadline for collecting them;
- If a conforming petition has been filed, a public consultation must be held.

### **By-law**

The *By-law concerning the Montréal Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and the Right of Initiative* (05-056) sets out the conditions for the application of the Right of Initiative to public consultations.

## NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQUIRED BY BOROUGH

This number corresponds to 5% of the number of people ages 15 years and over living within the territory of the borough in question. For highly populated boroughs, the minimum number of signatures is limited to 5000.

The number of people ages 15 years and over is determined using borough socio-economic profiles produced by the City and based on the most recent figures available from Statistics Canada.

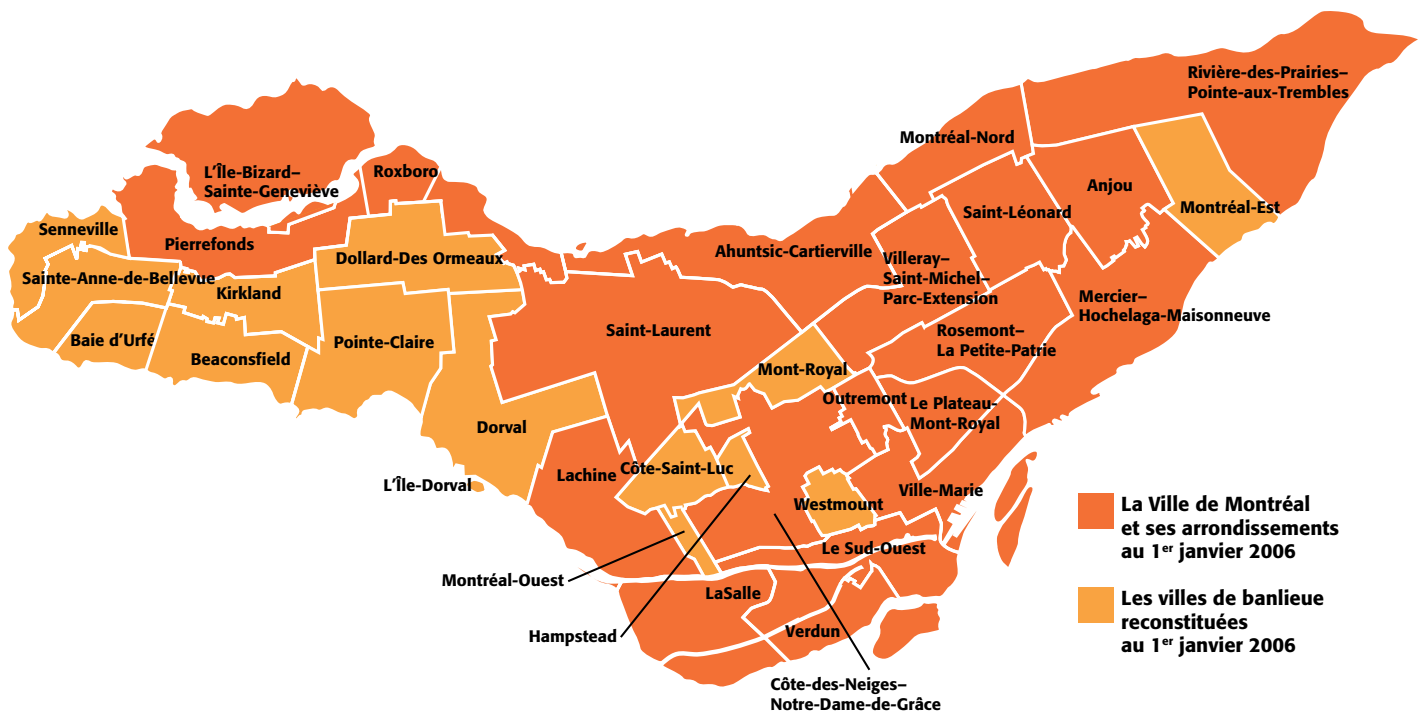
