

To His Honor the Mayor, the Aldermen
and Citizens of the City of Montreal,
in Council assembled,

The Memorial of the Subscribers,
Proprietors, or representing Proprietors, of
property in the St. Marg's Ward, respectfully
sheweth,

That for the accommodation of the
Inhabitants already established in the
vicinity, and in order to anticipate the
wants of a rapidly increasing population
it is necessary that Catherine Street
be forthwith extended, Eastwardly,
as far at least as Colborns Square.

That there is no natural obstacle to
such extension of Catherine Street;
but on the contrary, the low papers
over ground highly favorable for
the purpose of a Street.

That the proprietors of the property through
which such extension must be carried,
consist of your Memorialists and the
Heirs of the late Alexander Hart, whose
representative, acting under special and
limited authority, is precluded from
becoming a party to this Memorial
that, commencing at Victoria Road, the
first intervening property is that of your
Memorialist, the undersigned Miles
Williams; who hereby tenders to the City
the portion of his Emplacement that
may be required, by a breadth of sixty feet
by its whole depth of One Hundred and
forty feet; with an undertaking on his part
to exonerate the City from all liability
to remove, or replace, or erect, Buildings or
fences; for the sum of £200 - One Hundred
Pounds, represented by the City Bonds of
like amount, bearing Interest at Six
Cent and payable in four Years from
the date of the arrangement,
