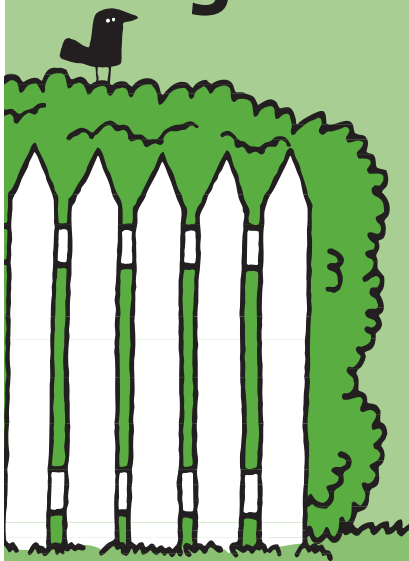


Fences, low walls and hedges

You would like to spruce up your property by adding a fence, a low wall or a hedge? The Borough of LaSalle, concerned about your safety and good relations with your neighbours, has summarized, below, the guidelines and standards you must know before starting your work. Following these directions will help you ensure the success of your home development projects.

Location

A fence, hedge or low wall must always be located along the property lines. They must also be in keeping with the following minimum distances:

- 61 cm from the sidewalk.
- 1.2 m from fire hydrants.

Height

Depending on the shape and location of your property, various standards apply to the height of the fence, low wall or hedge added. The illustrations above indicate the regulation heights.

Allowable materials

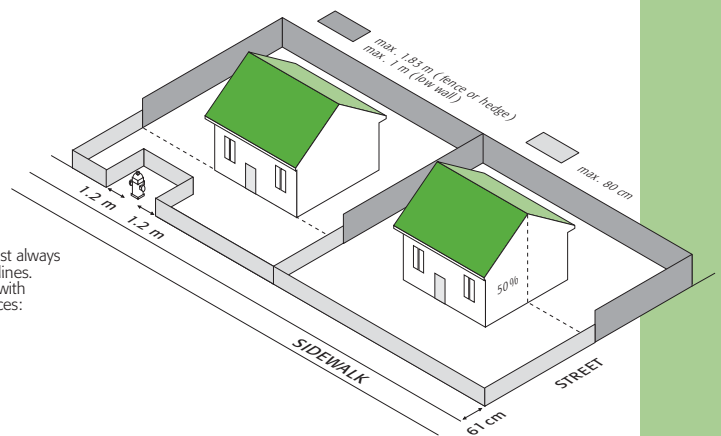
Wood: stained, painted, planed or varnished. It may be left natural if the fence is made of wooden rails.

Metal: must be ornamental and safe in order to prevent any risks of injury.

PVC: polyvinyl chloride resin.

Low wall: must be constructed and decorative.

Prohibited materials: barbed wire, sheet metal, chain link, chicken wire.



Certificate of authorization

Before installing your fence, low wall or hedge, you must obtain a certificate of authorization. To obtain one, you must provide a copy of the certificate of location of the property, two drawings of the location of whatever is to be added as well as its height (drawn on the certificate of location) and a description of the materials used.
