

Towards a Montréal roadmap in circular economy

The <u>Commission sur le développement économique et urbain et l'habitation</u> (committee) consults Montrealers on the proposed **Montréal's circular economy roadmap**.

As genuine tools for regional economic development, circular economy initiatives help to reduce the environmental footprint and contribute to the well-being of the whole community. The proposed roadmap contains 13 strategic priorities in 5 sectoral value chains.
