**OBTAINING/RENEWING
A MEMBERSHIP CARD**



A document with your proof of address and personal identity (including photo) must be presented in order to obtain a library card.

Documents must be your own and may not be those of a spouse or any other member of your family, with the exception of a youth membership.

PROOF OF ADDRESS DOCUMENTS ACCEPTED

- Driver's licence
- Utility bill (telephone, gas, etc)
- Government document
- Tax account slip
- Pay slip
- School document (including schedule)
- Bank statement
- Insurance certificate

PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION FEATURING YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

- Health insurance card
- School identification card
- Passport

DOCUMENTS NOT ACCEPTED

- Lease
- Hospital card
- Personal cheque
- Business card

BORROWING PRIVILEGES

A library card is required to borrow documents.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DOCUMENTS

A maximum of 40 documents (including 10 DVDs) may be borrowed from the Montréal Public Libraries Network.

BORROWING LIMITS PER CATEGORY

Novels, non-fiction, comics & mangas	25
New releases, CD-ROMs, audio books, periodicals, DVDs & CDs	10
DVD set	5
Language courses	3
Video games	2

BORROWING PERIOD

All documents	21 days
Except DVDs and video games	7 days

RENEWING DOCUMENTS

Documents may be renewed up to 3 times (with the exception of items reserved by another library user or late by more than 3 days). Video games may only be renewed once.

The service is available at the library by telephone or online during opening hours.

HOLDS & RESERVATIONS

Maximum of 3 holds and/or reservations per day, per patron.

The service is available at the library by telephone or online.

Reserved documents may be forwarded to the library of your choice.

All documents may be reserved with the exception of reference documents, games and toys, video games and consoles, iPads, laptops and 3D printers.

DIGITAL LIBRARY

DIGITAL RESOURCES

The website bibliomontreal.com/numerique offers access to newspapers and magazines, books, music, language and computer courses as well as a youth Web portal.

E-BOOKS

Borrowing period: 21 days (documents are chronodegradable and no late fees will be applied.)

Borrowing/reservation limit: 5 documents borrowed and 5 on hold at a time.

WIRELESS INTERNET

Simply bring your laptop computer, equipped with a Wi-Fi card, and request a user name and password at the reference or circulation desk.

Please note that library employees will not provide technical support with personal electronic devices.

COMPUTER STATIONS

Library users must have a library card and a password. The password must contain 6 to 10 numbers.

INTERNET RESERVATION PERIOD

- 30-minute blocks
- Maximum of 2 hours/day
- 4 hours/week

INTERNET EXPRESS TERMINAL:
15-minute blocks
available without reservation

PRINTING

Computer printer	\$0.25/page black & white
Photocopies	\$0.15/page black & white

In order to print from one of the computer stations, users may add money to their account (virtual wallet) at the circulation desk.

FINES

Fines are calculated per late day, per document, for individuals and groups. Persons who reach the maximum fine will have their borrowing privileges suspended.

ADULTS \$0.25
up to a maximum of \$3/document

CHILDREN AND SENIORS \$0.10
up to a maximum of \$2/document
