

UNIVERSAL ACCESSIBILITY

The library is designed to meet universal accessibility standards, so all visitors, including those with disabilities or functional impairments, can use and enjoy the space, safely and freely.

AREAS

WORKROOMS AND QUIET WORKROOM

Two study rooms are available for your team-working needs. A silent work area also provides you with the peace and quiet you need to work on your projects.

TRAINING ROOM

In our training room, you can develop a variety of skills and acquire knowledge relevant to different areas of your life. Check the programming for further details.

FABLAB AND MEDIALAB

The Library puts at your disposal various technological tools enabling you to create professional-quality content while remaining accessible to everyone: 3D printers, vinyl cutters, robotics and electronics sets, cameras and powerful computers.

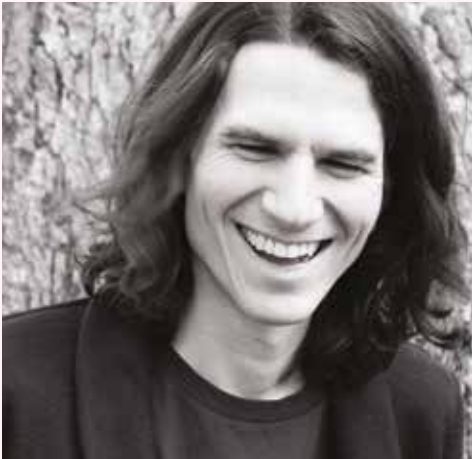
