Construction of embankment wall almost completed

Dear Sir or Madam,

The Ville de Montréal is pleased to inform you that the construction of an embankment wall at the intersection of Décarie and De Maisonneuve boulevards will be completed around mid-December.

The embankment wall is a major component of the railway overpass construction project because it will support the *Canadian Pacific* railway tracks for several months during the implementation of subsequent phases of this project, namely the demolition (phase 2) and rebuilding (phase 3) of the overpass.

Traffic and parking

Although the work is suspended, the roads underneath the Décarie overpass will still be closed to traffic. However, chemin Upper-Lachine will be completely re-opened to traffic in both directions. The sidewalk on the south side of chemin Upper-Lachine will be accessible again.

Ongoing and future work

Until February, the Commission des services électriques de Montréal (CSEM) will be improving the underground network on the west side of Décarie. The Ville de Montréal plans to begin rebuilding sewers and water mains along Décarie (west side), once the CSEM has finished its work.
