Why this project? In 2010, the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce (CDN—NDG) Borough Council mandated the Borough's *Direction de la culture, des sports, des loisirs et du développement social* (DCSLDS) to create a working committee whose goal would be to:

✓ Develop a project to revitalize the NDG Community Centre and the NDG indoor swimming pool and to draw up a plan to refurbish and upgrade the Centre Le Manoir.

Who is inviting you? The members of the revitalization committee, composed of eleven community groups providing services in those facilities, of citizens, and of representatives of the Borough of CDN—NDG.

What is the goal? The revitalization committee wishes to better know the needs and wants of residents in order to provide the best quality services and activities in these three facilities.

What is it? The Citizen Forum is a chance for all NDG residents to:

- ✓ Obtain information on work currently being done:
- ✓ Share their views and ideas on the choices to be made in aiming for an optimal delivery of services in these three facilities;
- ✓ Find out more about subsequent phases.

What is the project's framework? The revitalization committee's activities are accomplished within the context of allocation of resources governing the delivery of sports, recreation, and social development services.

What happens after the forum? A recommendation report will serve as a basis for designing a program of functional and technical guidelines that will allow work to proceed in the three facilities with the aim of optimizing their use and of delivering services and activities adapted to the wants and needs of NDG residents.
