

# ROADMAP TO ZERO EMISSIONS BUILDINGS IN MONTRÉAL BY 2040

The <u>Commission sur l'eau, l'environnement, le développement durable et les grands parcs</u> (committee) was mandated to hold a public consultation on a roadmap to zero emissions buildings in Montréal by 2040 (*Feuille de route vers des bâtiments montréalais zéro émission dès 2040*).

The consultation is part of an effort to reach greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) reduction targets and achieve carbon-neutrality in Montréal.

The committee invites interested parties to participate in the public consultation which will be held in three parts. The first part is an opportunity to learn about the city's proposals, ask questions and get answers on the subject. During the second part, attendees can express their views. The third part consists of a public session for the adoption of the recommendations that the committee will submit to the administration at the end of its review.
