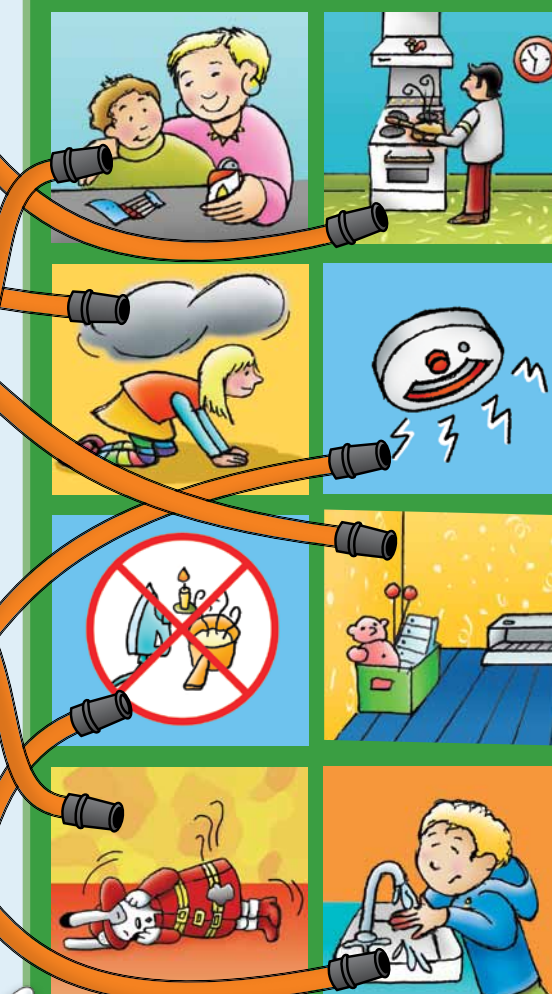
Safety mission
